Abstract : The aim of this book is to provide a comprehensive introduction to mouse genetics as a model system for genetic analysis. It envisages three types of readers: (1) the advanced undergraduate or graduate student working with mice for the first time, (2) the established molecular biologist about to work with mice, and (3) the practising geneticist. Following two introductory chapters, the remaining 8 chapters cover: (1) laboratory mice (sources, strains, nomenclature, etc.), (2) reproduction and the mouse genome, (3) mutagenesis and transgenesis, (4) an overview of

(6) genetic markers, (7) classical linkage analysis and mapping panels, and (8) breeding mapping strategies. There are appendices on suppliers of mice, tools and electronic databases, source materials for further reading, and standard methods, and a glossary of terms.
