Abstract : This revised edition of a book first published in 1963 includes a review (pp. 98-107) on drugs and chemicals in human milk. It lists drugs excreted in milk and reports on the concentration determined. It is recommended that the following be avoided while breast-feeding: any drug or chemical in excessive amounts, cocaine, atropine, reserpine, steroids, radioactive preparations, hallucinogens, anticancer drugs, bromides, anti-thyroid drugs, anthraquinones, dihydrotachysterol, antimetabolites.

perhaps oral contraceptives. Food-drug interactions (e.g. between dairy products and drugs such as bisacodyl, chlortetracycline, furazolidone, methacycline, penicillins, tetracyclines) are briefly discussed on pp. 306-307. There is also a section on zoonoses (pp. 542-557), mentioning diseases such as brucellosis that are transmitted from animals to humans. The question of food additives is dealt with on pp. 668-672 within a chapter on nutrition education, which also discusses food poisoning. There are several references to the use of milk (or evaporated milk) as a demulcent. In cases of carbon tetrachloride poisoning, however, milk is contraindicated because of its high fat content.
