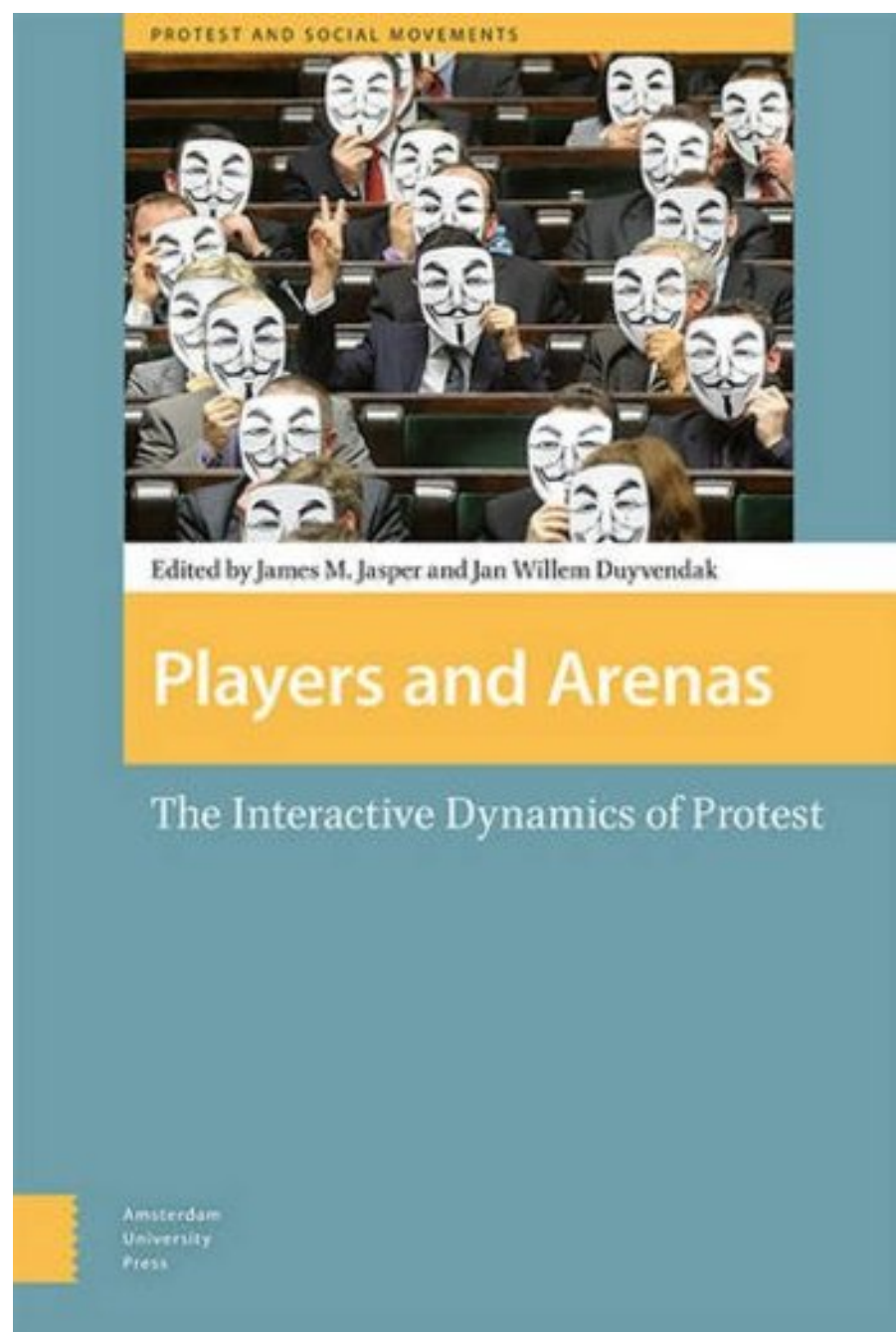


## Players and Arenas: The Interactive Dynamics of Protest
