What Is the Range of Current Teaching on Sanctification and What Ought a Wesleyan to Believe on this Doctrine?

Abstract

This article seeks to answer two questions: What is the range of holiness teaching in Protestantism and what ought a Wesleyan to believe on holiness? For the first question, we summarize the different positions on sanctification in various theological traditions of Protestantism, beginning with the most optimistic and ending with the most pessimistic. The similarities and differences among Christian traditions are brought to the fore, as well as the nuances among Wesleyan-Arminians. We seek to foster an appreciation for the historical understanding of holiness, while arguing for the need of the unique perspectives in evangelicalism.

In response to the second question, we define the core Wesleyan teaching on sanctification. While Wesleyan-Arminian views on holiness are common features to them, helping to define the center of "the Wesleyan tradition," to abandon these features is to leave our theological distinctives behind. We demonstrate that the Wesleyan position brings together the best of the Wesleyan tradition on sanctification into a more holistic view and offers a path to redemption in the present life.
