To borrow one of David Leff's puns, I “Thoreauly” enjoyed this book. Leff, a retired deputy commissioner in the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection, follows Thoreau's paddle-strokes from *A Week on the Concord and Merrimack Rivers*. Not surprisingly, Leff finds that you

cannot paddle the same river twice. Things have changed, with the rivers now bordered in spots by purple loosestrife (an invasive plant that made its way to our shores after Thoreau's day) and in others by interstate highways, fast-food restaurants, and big-box stores. Thoreau's journey quite literally cannot be replicated, because he took a six-mile cutoff on the Middlesex Canal—which long ago fell into disuse and has mostly been filled in and built over.
