Abstract : In question and answer form, this book introduces the basic concepts of patenting, explaining the necessary steps and pitfalls to avoid in simple non-technical language. A glossary of patent terminology is also included. Differences in patent regulations in different countries are covered by case studies of actual patent applications. Sections on legal protection for plants and animals, patenting genes and genetic engineering methods and strategies. Answers to so

questions are somewhat vague; under "How do I know if I have an invention patenting?" the reader is advised to trust his or her intuition, learn by experience, and persevere. In general, however, this book should be a useful introduction to the field, though the current rate of change of rulings and conventions may mean that some details are soon out of date.
