A Guide to Books about Mystery and Detective Fiction, compiled and annotated by Jon Breen. The volume under review is a supplement to that book. Breen states the purpose of the work in the introduction to the first volume: "While this is a bibliography, and as complete as the compiler can make it in point of titles covered, its main purpose is to evaluate the titles listed, to try to give the reader some idea not just of what the books are and do but of which ones are worth reading, which are to be avoided, and where the others fall in the vast area in between" (p xi). This volume, the supplement, analyzes 565 reference-type books about mystery and detective fiction written between 1981 and 1991. The entries are divided into eight chapters: histories (5 entries); reference books (52 entries); special subjects such as British spies, women detectives, Nancy Drew,

and black characters...
