Abstract : The study aimed to examine how individual differences in motivation influenced the experience of climbing Ayers Rock. In particular, the study explored the relationship between intrinsic versus achievement motivation on task enjoyment and time perception.

hundred and seventeen climbers were studied and their motivation was as post climb multi-faceted classification procedure. The hypothesis that people intrinsically motivated would enjoy the climb more than those who were achievement motivated was supported. Additionally, it was found that achievement motivated individuals tended to perceive time passing more slowly than actual time while intrinsically motivated people tended to perceive time passing more quickly than actual time. It was also found that people who enjoyed the climb experienced time passing more quickly than people who experienced less enjoyment. The study highlights management outcome and methodological issues which can result from 'on research.
