Abstract: Like one of those planetary alignments that occur from time to time, this year occasions the commemoration of four key dates in the Irish- Australian mental landscape: two events in Australian history, and one in Irish literary culture that also has apparent significance in this country. There is a fourth anniversary that for me is the most important of them all, though as far as I know no one else is aware of its existence, at least not in official Irish-Australian academic and cultural circles. In any

case, this fourth event would sit somewhat awkwardly with the Ireland of the mind that Irish-Australians, and Australians in general, seem to prefer.
