

Grotius's attempt to find a compromise both between reason and revelation, and between free will and predestination, the reading of Scripture, his refusal to engage in doctrinal disputes, and his insistence on ethics as the core of Christianity are important in shaping a powerful strand of thinking about the Anglican church from the Great Tew circle to post-Reformation references to Grotius's apologetic work which appeared in moderate Anglican writing should be understood by set

encompassing the settlement of Anglican Church, its religious doctrine, and its relations with civil authority. In order to provide the political and ecclesiological context for the English translations of De Veritate, I will divide the period from 1630 into three phases: the initial phase goes back to the 1630s, when the members of the Great Tew circle at Oxford facilitated the translations and editions of De Veritate in England within the context of Caroline/Laudian religious policy. The second phase covers a number of Grotius's works were translated by the Anglican theologian Clement Barksdale in order to provide a new synthesis for the Anglican Church. The third phase spans from the Restoration until 1686, when De Veritate converged in the complex background of 'latitudinarianism'.
