Abstract : Although the title implies that this work is concerned only with Nigeria, a wide deal of information about vegetational associations and mammalian distribution in West and Central African territories (Senegal to Uganda) is included. This wider scope is presented in a coloured map of the vegetation zones of these lands and an index cover is provided for each mammal by indicating in the text its distribution for

Particular emphasis to mammalian distribution in Nigeria is given in about 24 each showing for a single species its known distribution and probable range territory. A larger-scale, coloured map shows the limits of the principal vegetation in Nigeria, rivers, place names and political boundaries, etc. The small maps cover repeat the natural features and commoner place names. Some 30 pages of text define the vegetational zones, which are clearly illustrated in 40 good photographs. The text discusses their history and changes due to shifting cultivation and regenerative agriculture. The influence of these current modifications on animal dispersal is pointed out by Bertram. Brief sections deal with climate, special habitats and faunal barriers in Nigeria. The distribution of mammals is set out in full zoological classification with, for each species, data on range, frequency, type locality and subspecies besides the common and scientific names.
