This early essay of Spencer's was originally published anonymously in The Leader for March 20 1852. It was the second contribution in a regular series entitled "The Haythorne Papers". Spencer's identity was revealed some while after. It is reproduced in Herbert Spencer, *Essays Scientific, Political & Speculative*, Williams and Norgate (3 vols 1891) pp.17]; and here in full. 
