Abstract: We have previously looked at a bare sketch of the 'story' of the physical universe as we currently know about it, and bewailed the lack of wonder about this story among people living in the increasingly artificial and educated environments of our new third millennium. Wonder of a superficial, 'gee whizz!' type is in reasonable

supply, but on looking more closely, this reaction seems just to be little more than just shallow amazement at our own human cleverness in finding out about some such matters. This stops well short of a decentering, religious wonder at the 'works of God' themselves.
