Abstract : This book contains 3 sections: introductory chapters describing the background to the use of medicinal herbs in North America; chapters discussing 29 of the most popular herbs currently sold in the USA (for each one, clinical patient information sheets and single herb monographs are provided); and for 13 proprietary herbal products used in clinical studies. The monographs provide information on primary uses supported by clinical trials, potential uses, doses,

duration of use, pregnancy and lactation guidelines, contraindications, adverse drug interactions, pharmacological actions and mechanisms of action, clinical tables summarizing clinical trials, and brands used in clinical trials. An index found in this book, as well as an appendix section are provided. The book is for physicians, pharmacists, nurses, dieticians and other healthcare professionals. It also be of interest to herbalists and consumers.
