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### Abstract or Description:

The *Invention of Craft* is the sequel to Adamson's 2007 book *Art and Craft in the 20th Century*. The 2013 sole-author book continues Adamson's core argument is that craft was 'invented' during the 20th century, seeing artisanal customs and traditions as an unmoving backdrop for an active, dialogical process in which craft played a part in the discussions of contemporary practice: if the late 18th and early 19th century production, then we are now seeing a reconvergence in which the late 18th and early 19th century reference point.
