### Abstract

Excavations at Anderson's Armoury in Colonial Williamsburg dating to the last quarter of the 18<sup>th</sup> century. The position of the site containing the articulated remains of roosters, a duck, and a cat may have been used in dog fighting. An alternative hypothesis may have instead been used for the purposes of working and fighting.
