Abstract : This book traces the history of international environmental negotiations, regulations, and looks at the domestic policies upon which cooperation in the international community depends. Chapter 2 summarizes the 'prehistory' of international environmental politics.

action leading up to the first wave of popular environmental concern in the 1960s. Chapter 3 looks at the first international manifestation of this concern, the Stockholm Conference of 1972. Chapter 4 reviews national responses to this with sections on national population policies, and the implications of national policies. Chapter 5 looks at international concerns over this same period (mainly acid rain, endangered species, desertification etc.). Chapter 6 examines events of the 1980s including the response to the Chernobyl accident, negotiations regarding Antarctica, international toxic waste management, and the ozone layer. Issues of the 1990s are then considered. Chapter 7 is devoted to climate change, chapters 8 to biodiversity and chapters 9 and 10 to the Rio Summit. Chapter 11 considers how the international system can respond and adapt to current concerns and reflect the implications of this for the future.
