

From Christian Worldview to Kingdom Formation: Theological Education as Mission in the Former Soviet Union.

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Abstract:

Evangelical theological education in the Former Soviet Union has reached a crucial phase in its history. Evangelical academic leaders throughout this huge region are seeking the kind of visions and values that are needed to navigate into an uncertain but exhilarating future. The aim of this article is to outline the contours of a holistic vision of theology that goes beyond both worldview formation and practical training in church activities. It is argued that the development of a contextual missional paradigm that could be used to invigorate evangelical theological education and mission in the Former Soviet Union is one of the most urgent tasks of evangelical theology in Slavic contexts today.

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
