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Literature on the Margins: Russian Fiction in the Nineties

Despite shrinkage in print runs and readership, canonical Russian literature developed along three major lines that connected writers of various aesthetic and philosophical orientations: realism, exemplified in Georgii Vladimirov's novel, *The General and His Army* (1994); postmodernism, richly represented in the fiction of Vladimir Sorokin, Viktor Pelevin, and Vladimir Sharov; and, as derived from the naturalism of early perestroika, most convincingly in Liudmila Petrushevskaya, Liudmila Ulitskaya, and, in his paternalistic style, *Russia's chief theorists of postmodernism, Mikhail Epshtein. ... to the status of mainstream, which they failed to attain, owing to the instability that chaos theory has labeled a "bifurcation cascade" stage, according to specialists in chaos theory, leads to irreversible collapse. ... high level of stability, the outlook for Russian literature at century's end is bleak than prophesied by doomsayers.*
